THE STORY OF PUNCHES

It was the 'Golden Age' of rail which saw the founding of the St Pancras Midland Grand Hotel. This coincided with the birth of the cocktail, which began a movement that would eventually see drinks from all over the world coming to London's bars, as noted by Dickens:

"The bar is a large room with a stone floor, and there people stand and smoke, and lounge about, all the evening dropping in and out as the humour takes them. There too the stranger is initiated into the mysteries of Gin-sling, Cocktail, Sangaree, Mint Julep, Sherrycobbler, Timber Doodle, and other rare drinks."

Dickens was also a renowned antiquarian; punch, which had fallen out of fashion, was a great ritual for the famous writer to perform for his friends; it also had the added bonus of being a little rebellious, considering Queen Victoria's judgments of the lax morals of the upper classes.

This list includes a variety of Punches, 'fancy' drinks and cocktails inspired by Dickens' letters and travels and other great Victorian writers such as Lewis Carroll, Robert Louis Stevenson and Arthur Conan Doyle.

PUNCHES

Charles Dickens punch for 10

Bowl 150 / mug 15

Pineapple infused rum, Hennessy VS and demerara sugar. Mix the sugar and alcohol, then heat until the sugar dissolves, extinguish the flame, then add the juice of lemons and boiling water. Pour the liquid into a jar and cover, allow to cool, then uncover, taste and serve.

Billy Dawson's punch for 10

Bowl 150 / mug 15

In an earthenware bowl muddle the peel of lemons with demerara sugar, then add boiling water and stir to dissolve the sugar. To this, mix lemon juice, Jamaican Rum, Golden Rum, Cognac, Batavia Arrack and good porter. Stir this and then add boiling water. Can be served hot or cold, with the addition of nutmeg.

The Cat's Whiskers punch for 10

Bowl 150

In an earthenware bowl, prepare quarter wheels of orange, lemon, lime, diced pineapple and seasonal berries. To this, add Old Tom Gin, berry liqueur, orgeat and sugar water. Serve over decorative ice and top with a bottle of Chapel Down English Sparkling Wine.
